## Lemon Drizzle Cake

**Serves 8**



### Ingredients

125g butter or margarine  
125g caster sugar  
2 eggs  
185g self raising flour  
a pinch of baking powder  
1 lemon, rind grated and juiced  
1/4 cup milk, or as needed  
4 tablespoons icing sugar

### Step 1

Grease and line 20cm deep cake tin. Preheat oven to 160 degrees C.

### Step 2

Beat together the butter, caster sugar, eggs, self-raising flour, baking powder, the lemon rind and enough milk to make a fairly soft consistency.

### Step 3

Put into tin and bake for about an hour until well risen and springy to touch.

### Step 4

Mix together icing sugar and 3 tablespoons lemon juice in a pan over very low heat.

### Step 5

As soon as cake comes out of oven prick top of cake with fine skewer and pour the icing/syrup over it. Leave to cool in tin for 10 minutes then transfer to rack to finish cooling.

## ADSA WALK FOR RESEARCH AND AWARENESS TO PASS THROUGH YARLOOP

The Asbestos Diseases Society of Australia Inc (ADSA) is a caring charitable organisation that has for more than 35 years provided a unique service to asbestos diseases sufferers, their families, and the Western Australian community, assisting with the many issues arising out of exposure to asbestos and its devastating consequences. The epidemic of asbestos diseases in Western Australia is affecting members of the community from all walks of life in greater numbers as each year passes. In 2017 the ADSA recorded 332 asbestos caused deaths.

Mr Robert Vojakovic AM, JP, President of the ADSA said, "There is no safe level of asbestos exposure and mesothelioma can be contracted with only minimal exposure to asbestos from home renovations or unsafe work practices. Asbestos was used in commercial, public, and residential

buildings in Australia from 1920 to 1987 and indeed recent illegal imports have also been used in our buildings. For many years to come carcinogenic asbestos fibres will remain in the community and it is essential that people are aware of what they need to do to reduce the risks for themselves and their families."

The ADSA Walk 2018 is from Wave Rock, Hyden to Perth via Kondinin, Kulin, Wickepin, Narrogin, Williams, Quindanning, Harvey, Yarloop, Waroona, Pinjarra, and Serpentine. This is an annual event to raise lifesaving funds for the Asbestos Diseases Society of Australia PhD Scholarship in Mesothelioma supervised by Professor Anna Nowak and the NCARD team at the University of Western Australia and also to raise awareness of the risks of asbestos exposure.

The ADSA is also pleased to announce the launch of a dedicated website for the ADSA Walk, [adsawalk.org.au](http://adsawalk.org.au), where the Walk Team can be followed online through daily posts. The ADSA Walk history and information about the ADSA PhD Scholarship along with photo galleries can also be viewed at [adsawalk.org.au](http://adsawalk.org.au).

On Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2018 the ADSA Walk Around Town will be held in Harvey from 11am to 2pm. Starting from the Harvey Community Resource Centre on Gibbs Street the Walk is a 1km loop including Young Street, Uduc Road and Hayward Street. Registration is from 10am at the Harvey CRC. The ADSA Walk 2018 will pass through Yarloop on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018 from 9.00 am. Join the walk group, in a short walk around the town, ending at the Yarloop CWA rooms on Station Street at 9.30am for a cup of tea or coffee and morning tea.


## BUSHFIRE PREPAREDNESS DVD HAS BEEN LAUNCHED

On Thursday the 23<sup>rd</sup> August the Shire of Harvey launched the Bushfire Preparedness DVD that is based on the lessons learned by local residents who experienced the January 2016 Bushfires. The Bushfire Preparedness DVD was funded by the Natural Disaster Resilience Program formed by the Australian Federal Government to fund priority disaster resilience initiatives. The 2016-17 was a competitive grants round attracting 41 submissions, requesting over \$2.8 million. Of these applicants, 12 were successful including the Shire of Harvey.

Bushfires are a natural part of Australian life, and they happen every year. The Bushfire Preparedness Project has taken a different approach to promote the importance of being prepared by using the power of storytelling.
